



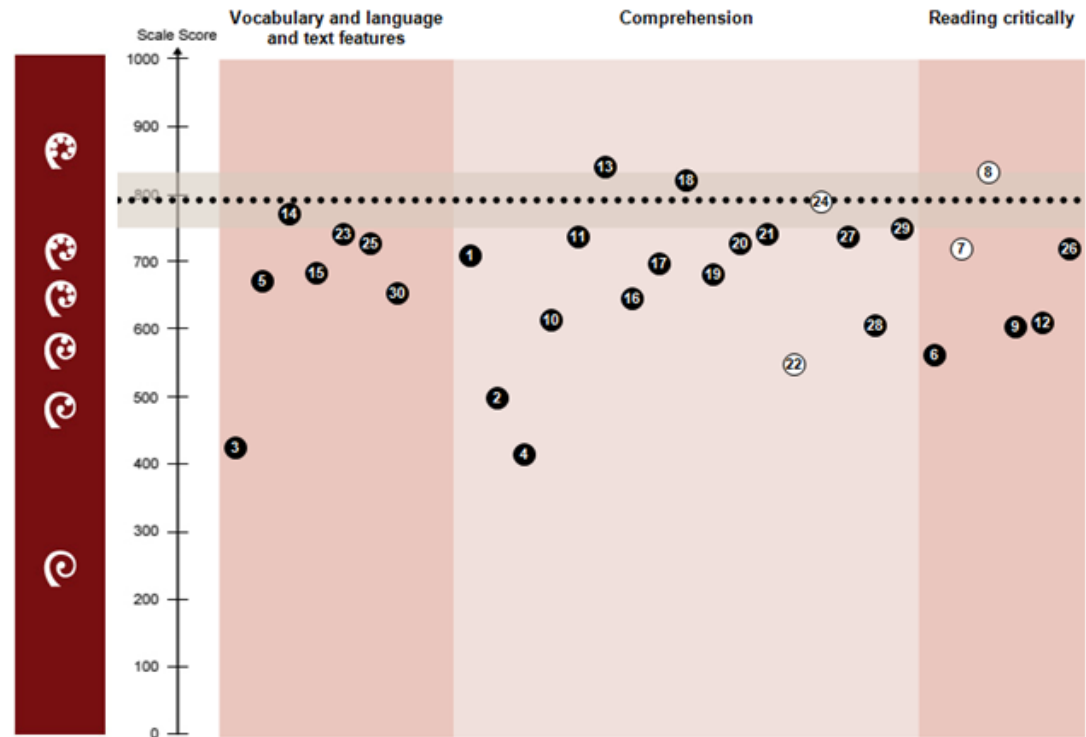

The reading, writing and maths demands of your course may be at step 5 or 6.

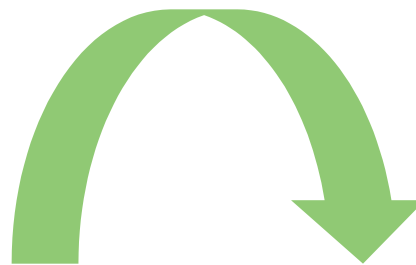

Learning Progressions

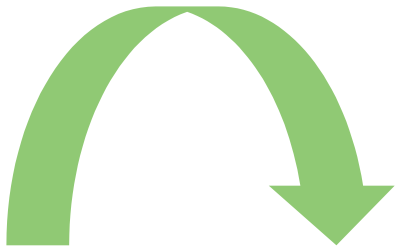


- If your report shows there is a gap between the step you are on and the step needed for your course, a learning programme will be developed to help strengthen your skills.

- With a Success Plan, you will work with a Learning Centre tutor regularly, making sure you are keeping up with your work and you are improving your reading, writing and maths skills.
